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# Overview

Although COVID-19 continues to dominate much of our work, South Carolina continues to face many other serious health challenges. Some, such as obesity, high blood pressure and diabetes, put our citizens at higher risk for COVID-19. Others, such as suicide and drug abuse, appear to be increasing because of anxiety, isolation and economic uncertainty caused by the pandemic. As a leading voice for healthcare in South Carolina, the South Carolina Hospital Association (SCHA) will undertake a coordinated, focused campaign to tackle the following eight health priorities during the coming years:

- Infant Mortality
- Low Birthweight
- Stroke Deaths
- Obesity
- Drug Overdose Deaths
- Suicide
- Delayed Medical Care
- Health Insurance Coverage

Our goal is twofold: to improve the overall population health outcome measures and reduce racial and ethnic disparities that exist in each of the eight areas. These priorities, which have been endorsed by our Board of Trustees, align with the [Live Healthy South Carolina State Health Improvement Plan](#) and support the Board's Equity, Diversity and Inclusion initiative.

As we [selected these priorities and created goals and strategies](#) over the past year, we knew our hospitals' partners and communities could not tackle these challenges alone. To truly make a difference in health and disparities, we all need to come together and leverage the power of local leadership and evidence-based best practices to make a collective impact.

To support these efforts, SCHA has created a county snapshot tool to help make sense of the data associated with these metrics. The County Report Cards will serve as a strategic tool to initially monitor baseline data and, in subsequent years, to examine performance and improvement efforts across the state. The data should be used to help understand how one county compares to another by domain, overall, and areas of greatest racial and ethnic disparities. You can use the County Report Cards to highlight strengths, identify potential challenges, and find opportunities as action plans associated with improving these key areas are developed.

SCHA has engaged our entire enterprise, including Solvent Networks and the SCHA Foundation, as well as our many partner organizations, in this effort. It will take all of us working together to impact these chronic conditions and build a better state of health for South Carolina.

# Methodology

SCHA's goal was to define a narrow set of indicators from the Live Healthy South Carolina State Health Improvement Plan, identify goals and strategies for each priority, and develop a County Report Card tool to evaluate SC counties.

A methodological approach using qualitative and quantitative criteria was applied to narrow the list of indicators to eight. The criterion includes indicators that have:

1. Hospital direct impact,
2. Current statewide initiatives,
3. Largest/Biggest impact for SC (Triple Aim),
4. SCHA's involvement with existing initiatives, and
5. Equity/Disparity gaps.

Once the eight indicators were finalized and approved by the Board, the County Report Cards were created for partners to demonstrate differences in health by geographic location and to promote collaboration and community health discussions about improving outcomes.

The County Report Cards include rankings from four domains and eight metrics. The rankings are divided into five quintiles, each of which is color-coded. The green colors indicate better health factors, and the red colors indicate poorer health factors in the respective summary rankings.

Z-scores are calculated for each measure, and composite measure scores are created. For the domain and overall county ranks, the standardized scores for the specific measures affected are averaged. Composite scores are then ordered, and counties are ranked from best to worst health within the state. Disparity rankings concentrate on the most affected racial and ethnic categories by measure. The same methodological approach is used to calculate domain and overall county ranks.

Formula used to calculate Z-scores:

$$Z = \frac{\text{County Value} - \text{Average of Counties in State}}{\text{Standard Deviation of Counties in State}}$$

Because select counties had insufficient sample size to report data (or missing values) on any individual measure, we used two strategies: 1) Utilizing multiple years of data so that counties will have adequate numbers for reporting measures, particularly due to the small sample size in the racial and ethnic disparity analyses and 2) Input (populate) data that represent the state mean as an estimate for counties with missing values. This was performed so that all counties will have domain and overall ranks. Eight measures had <2% of missing values. We chose this method so that we can easily communicate our methods to the public. County Health Rankings also apply this method.

A note on the ranking approach: According to [County Health Rankings](#), ranks are useful for garnering attention, simplifying complex data, and making comparisons between one community and another at a point in time—they should not be used alone to measure a single community's progress. Because ranks are relative, they are not as helpful in isolation -- your county's rank depends not only on what happens in your county, but also on what happens in all the other counties in the state. Look for ranks to inform your progress measurement, not drive it.

The standardized score methodology (Z-scores) of the County Report Cards parallel the County Health Rankings' methodological approach.

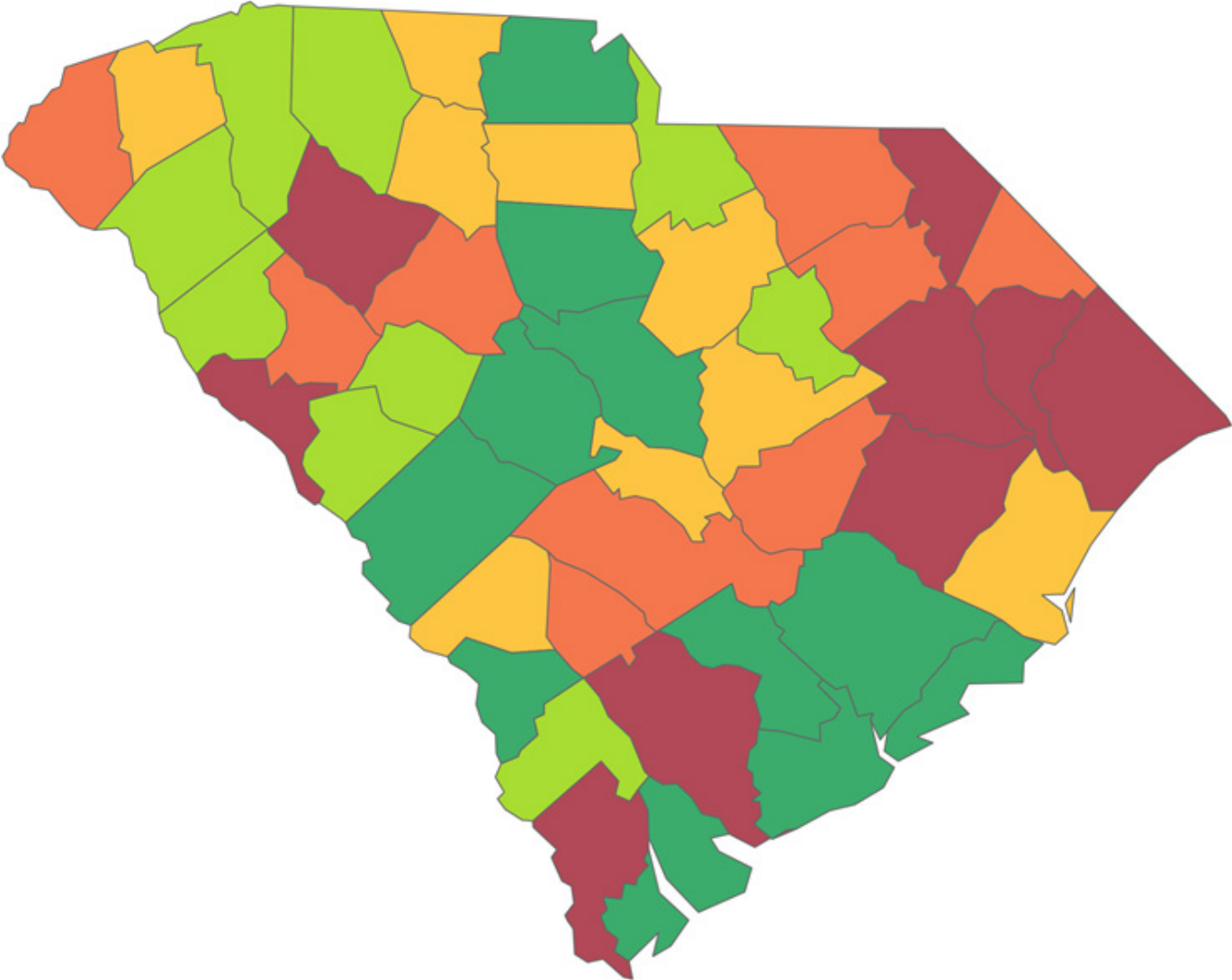
