Open Enrollment TALKING POINTS

- President Biden has ordered a special HEALTH INSURANCE OPEN ENROLLMENT PERIOD BEGINNING FEB. 15 to provide coverage to millions of Americans.
- This special open enrollment period will be three months, twice as long as recent open enrollment periods, WHICH MEANS SOUTH CAROLINIANS WILL HAVE UNTIL MAY 15, 2021 TO SIGN UP FOR 2021 COVERAGE.
- You can also check your eligibility for Medicaid and/or the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), which can provide free or low-cost health coverage to you or your family. MEDICAID AND CHIP DO NOT HAVE OPEN ENROLLMENT PERIODS.
- South Carolina hospitals and health systems are encouraged to WORK WITH NAVIGATORS AND OTHER COMMUNITY PARTNERS to help spread the word and get people covered in 2021.
- Over 200,000 OF SOUTH CAROLINIANS WHO ARE CURRENTLY UNINSURED ARE ELIGIBLE for Medicaid or Affordable Care Act Marketplace subsidies.
- MANY SOUTH CAROLINIANS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR \$0 PREMIUM BRONZE PLANS on the Marketplace after their subsidy, costing them nothing.

- 90% OF SOUTH CAROLINIANS WHO PURCHASE HEALTH INSURANCE ON THE MARKETPLACE RECEIVE A TAX CREDIT SUBSIDY. The average tax credit subsidy in 2019 was \$576 per month.
- 214,031 SOUTH CAROLINIANS PURCHASED A PLAN ON THE HEALTH INSURANCE MARKETPLACE IN 2019.
- Health insurance on the Marketplace is GUARANTEED TO COVER PRE-EXISTING CONDITIONS AND PRESCRIPTIONS, PROVIDES ESSENTIAL BENEFITS, AND CANNOT HAVE A LIFETIME CAP. Other short-term plans sold off the Marketplace will provide far less generous coverage.
- CERTIFIED BROKERS AND NAVIGATORS ARE AVAILABLE TO ASSIST FOLKS IN GETTING SIGNED UP FOR COVERAGE. Go to signupsc.org for more information.
